Camp Policies and Procedures

Camp Security and Drop Off/Pick Up Procedures:

For your convenience, the Nasher will offer drop off and pick up in front of the Center's main entrance on Flora Street. Parents must pull up to the front of the Center with the passenger side of their vehicle facing the Center doors. A staff member from the Nasher will be there to escort children into or out of the Center.

Upon arrival on Monday, parent must provide a list of any additional adults allowed to pick up the child. No child will be released to an adult not on a written list and not without showing photo identification.

Parents understand that no child can be dropped off before 8:45 am each morning. A Nasher staff member will be available at the front doors of the Center to welcome children by 8:45 am each day the camp is in session.

Snack:

The Nasher will provide campers with a light snack each day that camp is in session, but will not provide lunch. **If your child has food allergies or special dietary needs, please pack a snack for the child that does not require refrigeration for every day the camp is in session.** Parent acknowledges that the Center cannot provide a peanut-free environment.

Outside Environment:

Please apply sunscreen to your child every morning before they arrive at the Nasher. Many camp activities will take place in the outdoor garden and sunscreen will not be provided. Children may bring a hat or baseball cap to wear when outdoors.

Camp Dress Code:

Campers should wear comfortable clothing suitable for art activities and for extended exposure to the outdoors. A light jacket or sweater and an umbrella should be brought to the Nasher on days of inclement weather.

Photography:

The Nasher Sculpture Center reserves the right to use photographs of the participants taken during the Summer Camp for future publicity and promotions.

Refunds:

Registration in the Summer Camp is non-refundable unless notice of cancellation is received in writing on or before May 20. The Camp is subject to cancellation based on low enrollment. Registration will be refunded in full if camp is cancelled due to low enrollment. Notification of cancellation due to low enrollment will be published by May 20.

Waiver/Release:

By signing this Policies and Procedures Letter, the parent hereby covenants and contracts to release and indemnify, and hold harmless, the Nasher Sculpture Center as well as its employees, contracted art teachers, and volunteers, from any and all claims of whatsoever nature or type resulting from any act of commission, omission or negligence of the Nasher Sculpture Center or agents arising from activities under or related to the enrollment of their child for which a claim demand, suit, or other action may be made or brought by any person or other entity against the Nasher Sculpture Center.
